

The City of Elmhurst would like to remind its' residents of the 2010 Annual Spring Clean Up. Details are as follows:

Dates:

Residents with regularly scheduled collections on Wednesday will have Spring Clean-Up on

Wednesday, April 21.

Residents with regularly scheduled collections on Thursday will have Spring Clean-Up on

Thursday, April 22.

Residents with regularly scheduled collections on Friday will have Spring Clean-Up on

Friday, April 23.

Acceptable items are to be placed next to your regular refuse at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on collection day.

Items other than furniture, large appliances and bulk items must be placed in bags, cans or boxes, not to exceed 50 pounds each.

Yardwaste is **NOT** included in the Spring Clean-Up, but will be collected if properly prepared, stickered and set out on your regular collection day.

Allied Waste will collect the following large items **without a sticker**, from single family residences at the curbside:

Acceptable Items

- ▶ Appliances
- ▶ Bulk Items (bicycles, etc.)
- ▶ Carpet – must be in rolls no more than 5 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter.
- ▶ Construction and demolition debris (up to two cubic yards or equal to eight 33-gallon cans) **IN BOXES; CANS; BUNDLES (MAXIMUM 5 FEET IN LENGTH)**
- ▶ Fixtures
- ▶ Furniture
- ▶ Any paint must be hardened in cans with lids off.
- ▶ Landscape timbers – must be no longer than 3 feet in length.

Not Acceptable Items

- ▶ Yard Waste
- ▶ Car Batteries
- ▶ Explosives
- ▶ Tires
- ▶ Any type of liquid
- ▶ Ammunition
- ▶ Radioactive Materials
- ▶ Riding Lawnmowers or Snowblowers
- ▶ Hazardous or Medical Waste
- ▶ Large automobile parts
- ▶ Boats or Snowmobiles
- ▶ Bricks, Concrete Blocks, Cement or Asphalt pavement.
